Course Summary

This course enables on successful completion, the award of the Aerodrome Control Visual and Aerodrome Control Instrument rating with tower endorsement.

The course covers tower training on an enhanced visual simulator, with IFR and VFR aircraft movements and the control of vehicles around a large international airport environment.

The practical skills include:

- Runway safety;
- Ground Movement and Air control;
- Aviation hazards
- Traffic Integration
- Coordination
- Provision of Traffic information
- Cross runway operations

The theoretical subjects include among others:

- Aerodrome theory
- Aviation Law
- Air Traffic Management
- Equipment and Systems
- Human Factors
- Meteorology
- Navigation
- Abnormal and Emergency (ABES) / Degraded Situations

Entry Criteria

- Successful completion of UK Basic Training Course
- A valid European Class 3 medical (recommended)
- A good command of oral and written English, assessed towards ICAO proficiency level 4 during the course

The Aerodrome Control Instrument course is designed as a standalone course for those who have already completed the UK Basic training course and seek to work in a Tower environment, or ATCO licence holders seeking to obtain an additional rating.
