GENERAL AND AVIATION ENGLISH LANGUAGE MASTERCLASS

Course Summary

The ICAO circular 323 'Guidelines for English Training Programmes' defines the standards to be met in order to improve aviation communications worldwide, and states that their one single concern is safety. Effective and efficient training is key to meeting these standards. The specific aim of this course is to attain and maintain the language proficiency defined as ICAO Operational Level 4.

Course Components

There are two main components to the course: General English and Aviation English. The first of these will give delegates the opportunity to improve their language skills in a wider context, while the second practices the language in the more specific context of Aviation. The objectives of both course components overlap, and are designed to fit the requirements of the six categories for assessment set out in the ICAO Rating Scale.

Course Objectives

To improve, through guided practice, ability in the area of the 'Foundation Skills', namely:

- Pronunciation
- Vocabulary
- Listening Comprehension
- Grammatical Structure

To apply these in the context of the two additional 'Communicative Skills', namely:

- Fluency
- Interactions
